Invitation

Fellow volleyball players,

We are writing to invite you to our International Youth Tournament for boys born between the years 1995 and 1996 in Marzahn, Berlin that will take place on:

10th - 11th April 2010

We plan to meet on the following dates:

Fr. 09.04.2010	check in at 8pm
Sa. 10.04.2010	9.00am - grand opening 9.30am - then a meeting with the trainers 10am - tournament begins and at around 7pm play will be over for the day.
So. 11.04.2010	8am - the games begin! Around 16.00 clock Award Ceremony

The team shall consist of a maximum of 10 players born in the years 1995 and 1996 (or younger) plus 2 supervisors.

Arrangements for your overnight stay:

Choice A: you make your own arrangements

Choice B: Overnight accommodation with breakfast costing €7.50 for the night.

Tournament Rules:

- They will be 6 people on each team which will be played on a 9m² area. The net will be 2.24 metres.
- You are not allowed to use a "Libero".
- In order to win, you must win 2 lines.
- In addition, we will be following the standard, international volleyball rules.
- Those who have won in previous years will play first and the rest will play second

The tournament is limited to 12 teams. The order of play will be decided based on who we receive a response from first. The participation fee is €50.00 per team.

If you wish to attend, they we expect to hear from you before 01. February 2010 at the latest..
